Explanation of **Family Service Hour** opportunities

Listed below you will find an explanation of the various areas and activities where parents are needed. If you cannot join us in one of the following activities before, during or after school, there are many additional ways in which parents can share their untapped talents for the benefit of the children.

- A. Room Parent: Work with teachers and parents to coordinate duties such as lunch, computer and library activities. Duties would also include party planning, finding drivers, and any other requests the teachers may have.
- B. Library Aide: Assist the children in the library or help with clerical work.
- C. Computer Room Aide: Help students under the direction of the teacher to master computer based instructional materials using the computer.
- D. Lunch/Playground Duty: Monitoring your child's class during their lunch/recess hour.
- E. PTO Committees:
- \*Race for Education- Major PTO fundraiser. Entails gathering and inputting family addresses. Many of the pre-race details can be done outside the school after hours to better fit the schedules of parents who are unable to be at school during school hours.
  - \*Springfest- Good Shepherd School's May fair. Volunteer opportunities include planning, silent auction, raffle baskets, games, bake sale and clean-up.
  - \*Grandparent's Day- A special day where Grandparents or special friends are invited into the school to observe and take part in the child's school day. The day includes light refreshments, a Prayer Service, classroom visitations and lunch.
  - \*Social Committee/Teacher Appreciation- This group helps plan and provide events that bring the school together. Examples of responsibilities include Back to School nights, Christmas pageant social, teacher holiday luncheon and any family fun nights.
  - \*Catholic Schools Week- An opportunity to celebrate our Faith and dedication to Catholic Education with the community. Help is needed to plan for an open house as well as other activities throughout the week for the faculty and students.
  - \*Santa's Secret Shop- Group is responsible for planning, purchasing and selling of presents to students at Christmastime.
- F. Building Beautification: This may include anything from inside and outside general care of the building and facility.
- G. Book Fair: Library fundraiser that includes planning, setting up, selling and assisting the students with their purchases.
- H. Hot Lunch Server: Serves hot lunch to students on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 11am to 1pm.
- I. Track & Field Day: Assisting the Physical Education teacher with recording of event scores.
